#### **July 7/8 Llangollen** *Richard Coghlan*

Llangollen Tourist Information Office have confirmed that all footpaths and climbing areas in the vicinity are open.

This is intended to be a one day climbing meet on the Sunday and some people may decide to drive out just for the day - it's only two hours from Derby. However, I shall be camping at Wern Isaf (Grid Ref. 223426) just underneath the castle on Saturday night. The campsite fee is £3 per person per night, irrespective of number tents. If you decide to join me, you may see me at the campsite or in the bar of the Bridge End Hotel (about 10 minutes walk down the road).

The climbing venue is Craig-Y-Forwen, better known as World's End, the best crag in the area for middle and lower grade climbs (but there are plenty of E5s if you fancy a go). The climbs are limestone and less than 25m high, so a short rope will suffice. Craig-Y-Forwen is at Grid Ref 234478 in the Eglwyseg valley running North of Llangollen.

It's that time of the year for a beautiful summer evening amongst the spires of Dovedale. I won't be climbing due to a very inconvenient 'frozen shoulder' but I suggest that we all, climbers and walkers, gather after the sun sets at The George in Alstonfield.

#### **14/15 July The Lakes Gill Heys**

At the time of writing the situation regarding FMD in the Lake District is improving, but still unsettled. Access to the High Fells and crags is limited and it isn't entirely clear how much walking is available or how to approach some of the high level crags (many low level crags are not available for climbing).

In view of this and after talking over the situation with a few other members, I have decided to move the meet from the Lakes to North Wales. Here, the opportunities for climbing and walking are no longer restricted. Due to a cancellation, I have been able to book Tan yr Wyddfa with Colin Hobday. #### **July 28/29 Gogarth Brian West**

No introduction needed, just one of the best crags in the country.

I shall be camping at what used to be called the 'Valley of the Rocks' site, presently home to the Anglesey Sea & Surf Centre. SH 236805.

Take the coast road NW from Trearddur Bay. After 3km turn right at Porth Dafarch, then shortly right again into site entrance. Bear left past buildings then blunder about in gorse bushes as usual.

Saturday I expect to be climbing on the Main Cliff then swimming in the surf. Let us hope there is no causal connection between the two.
