The Club Hut -

BRYN-Y-WERN,  
CWM PENNANT,  
GARN DOLBENMAEN, CAERNS.

Bryn-y-Wern is situated in the delightful Pennant Valley in the heart of the South Snowdonian mountains. It is within easy walking distance of Cwm Silin, Tremadoc Cliffs, Moel Hebog and the Pennant Valley crags.

At one time a Vicarage it is a large stone building standing in its own grounds above the Afon Dwyfor.

Position. O.S. 1 in. map 107 or 116. Grid ref. 524453.

Approaches. Turn off the main Caernarvon - Portmadoc road, A 4085, at either Dolbenmaen, or  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile west of Penmorfa. At Pont Gyfyng an unsurfaced road leads off left over a bridge and across a field to Bryn-y-Wern.

Bus service. Caernarvon-Portmadoc, alight Dolbenmaen, 2 miles walk to hut.

Trains. From the North of England and Midlands to Caernarvon. From London, South and Birmingham areas, to Portmadoc. Cars, motorcycles, etc., may be parked at the rear of the hut.

General. The hut contains: lounge, dining room, two kitchens, drying room, bathroom, etc., 5 bedrooms, providing sleeping accommodation for 30 people. Sleeping bags are necessary.

Lighting is by Tilley lamp, cooking by Calor gas and Primus stoves. There is a boiler for hot water supply, a plentiful supply of coal, coke, wood and paraffin.

All crockery, pans, cutlery, etc. is provided.

Members and guests staying at Bryn-y-Wern may fish the Afon Dwyfor below the hut.

Rubbish. All food scraps and paper, etc., should be burnt on the boiler, and all tins put in the pit provided.
