Work at Ten - yr - Wyddfa.

The following report was to have appeared in the next newsletter but as the date of publication is uncertain the Hut Sub - Committee have decided to put out this circular separately.

Thanks are extended to members & prospective members whose efforts on the working parties of 27th. - 28th. August and 22nd. - 23rd. October have led to the Sub - Committee's primary plans being carried out. Sixteen people attended the first working party, and ten the second.

Work carried out was as follows:-

1. Dining Room.

Old wooden floor taken out, cavity filled with hard-core & floor finished in concrete.

Walls faced at floor level.

Walls sealed, & painted one coat. Ceiling painted.

Interior wall of bay window stripped of plaster & re-rendered in water-proof cement.

Tables dismantled, thoroughly cleaned and re-assembled.

2. Boiler Room.

All junk removed, Two walls pointed and one coat of emulsion paint applied.

3. Passage-way.

Old ceiling stripped down, levelled & made good with plaster board and skimmed.

4. Exterior.

Downstairs bays & window cills examined & found to be sound. One bay treated internally, (see ~~lounge~~ dining room,) to cure damp. Lounge bay will need similar treatment shortly. Some external painting carried out. Certain sections of woodwork found to be rotten & will require replacement soon.

5. Bedrooms.

All bedrooms cleaned out, mattresses beaten, brushed & aired. Blankets brought back to Derby & washed.

6. Roof.

False roof cleaned out of old mortar etc. which was giving rise to damp.

6. Kitchen.

Walls washed down.
