To start the new meets list off well, this rather unusual meet has been arranged. It is proposed to camp well up in the Cwm which is one of the most isolated in Snowdonia. Craig yr Iafa dominates the end of Eigiau and gives fine routes of all difficulties far away from the crowds of Ogwen. The Carnedd Climbing guide also gives reference to quite a number of worth while cliffs within range of the Cwm.

Transport will be by private cars etc. The meet leader will arrange lifts and offers of lifts. The small village of Dolgarrog on the B5106 is the meeting place on Friday night. When all those on the meet have arrived it is proposed to drive to Tal-y-bont where a good track leads into Cwm Eigiau. It is not known how far this track will take motors but when it does give out the rest of the way is for those willing and able to walk. It is proposed to pitch close to the stream a little way past "Cedryn" (O.S. Map No. 107 Ref. 717638.)

By the way, the B5 106 leaves the A5 at Bettws -y- Coed. Lets have a good turn out for this occasion which is not necessarily a "Hard Man meet".
