THIRLMERE

'WALKY' SMITH

This is the first Oread meet at Thirlmere, an area popular with walkers but not too well known as a climbing centre. Camping will be at High Bridgend at Legburthwaite at the north end of Thirlmere. (G.R.315193). It is usually possible to purchase milk and frozen foods (a Birds Eye shop!) from the farm. The 'Eastern Fells' guidebook lists many climbs on Raven Crag and Castle Rock, both within 10 minutes of the campsite, the climbs being amongst the best in the Lake District. The South Buttress of Castle Rock offers climbing of all standards for the not too ambitious, while there is always Helvellyn for those inclined to walk and the Thirlspot Inn for a good thirst quencher afterwards.

WELSH WALK

This year the plan is to walk over the Berwyns and Arans to finish in Cwm Cowarch. The distance is not over long, but this is not meant as a 'flog', the idea is to spend the full weekend over the walk. The rendezvous for Friday night is the village inn at CYNWYD (near Corwen) from which it is intended to 'bivvy' above/in the Forestry plantation, and then traverse the Berwyns and 'bivvy' in Cwm Hirnant.
