This area is excellent for both climbers and walkers and I believe too for water ski fans. Dow offers some of the finest routes in the Lake District with climbs of all grades on good rock, whilst in the unlikely event of bad weather some fine walks may be found, in the surrounding district.

Cars may be left at Church House Inn, Torver, having first gained permission from the publican, although it has been known for a certain Oread to get his vehicle up to the hut, but this is not recommended, particularly for Mini owners.
