The L.C.C. hut TRANEARTH has been booked a year in advance for this ever popular meet. Dow Crag lies on the East face of the mountain of that name, 2½ miles due West of Coniston. The Fell and Rock guide book (Dow Area 1968) contains over 60 routes, & many on outlying crags in the area. For those intending to do the classic Eliminate A route The 'Rochers perches' pitch has now lost its perched blocks. A smooth corner has been revealed & now requires a peg for aid. The pitch remains V.S. The peg is in situ & should be treated with care.

Beds are limited to 30 please book in advance. Camping is allowed near by.
