YORKSHIRE 3 PEAKS.

Camping for this weekend is to be at the rear of the Golden Lion Hotel-Horton-in-Ribblesdale ( O.S. Map No. 90- Ref 80972I ). Using Hotel car park and toilet facilities.

Suggested route is via MI, A65 to Settle and B6479 To Horton. The intention is to walk the 3 Peaks on the Saturday. This is due to the annual Fell Race taking place on the Sunday ( Any fit Oread feel like trying to beat the current record of approx 2 hours 42 mins.? )

Apart from the 3 Peaks the local area provides plenty of alternatives. Climbing on 3 local crags ie. Twistleton Scars, Crummackdale and Langcliffe Quarry or with a not too lengthy drive all areas listed in Yorkshire Limestone Guide Book are within easy reach. Visits can also be made to local caves ie. Skirwith and White Scar or a liesurely potter can be made from Ingleton to visit the local waterfalls.

CWM COWARCH.

This meet is something of a 'classic' in the Oread calendar and is a 'must' for those who wish to sample a different blend of mountain environment. The Hut is a splendid building, of almost alpine appearance standing on a small promontory at the head of Cwm Cowarch, (map ref. 853I92 O.S. I" Map No. II6 )

The hut holds something like 30 persons in 'Matratzenlager' type bedding. It is approached from Dinas Mawddy village via the unclassified road to Aber Cowarch (I mile) where a turning sharp left along the bridle road to Ceunant is taken. Cars should be parked at the end of the road adjacent to a small wooden footbridge crossing the Afon Cowarch river which incidently borders an idyllic pasture ideal for camping.

The crags are all situated in the immediate vicinity of the hut. The standard work on the area is in the Mountain Club Guide to Cwm Cowarch.

For the hill walkers an enjoyable weekend can be had on the nearby Aran hills.
